**1. Present**

- a. Apologies: Sue Campbell. Ruth Tott had asked not to be included due to Paul's quoting for works.

**2. S & C Crawford Quotes:**

- a. Floor repairs: It was agreed that we should accept the quote for all joist ends and centres. We would like Stewart to give us a price to replace the floorboards instead of relaying them. We would then need an amended original quote removing the cost of relaying the floorboards. We would like a fixed timescale for the work if possible.
- b. Slate repairs: It was agreed to accept this quote.
- c. Ventilation: It was agreed to accept this quote.
- d. Rainwater investigation: It was agreed that this should go ahead at the price quoted.

**3. Bar preparation and painting quote:**

The committee were not happy that the quoted price is the same per hour as our professional painter, but it was agreed that we should go ahead as the work needs to be done. We would like Paul to paint just the bar and the entrance hall. He can start in the bar right away, but the entrance hall will need to wait until Jeff is finished. Paul has offered to help Jeff, but Jeff would prefer to work on his own. Paul will be told this (nicely).

**4. AOCB**

- a. We should hear about the Screwfix grant at the end of June.
- b. We have met our quota of lottery ticket sales (thank you Sharon). We don't know if the money we are due will be paid monthly or annually.

- c. A new stainless steel plaque for Roddy's tree has been ordered. This one doesn't come with a stand, so it was suggested we get a nice piece of stone from the quarry and attach it to that instead. The Committee were in agreement.
  - d. The Community Council has awarded us a micro grant of £250. We need to formally write to the Chair to request it.
